KEY TO MY HEART

Caliber PF-001 begins its life at the Paul Forrest manufactory in the Val de Travers in Fleurier, Switzerland. With the express purpose of driving the “beating heart” of the Paul Forrest Heart’s Passion, this movement took about three years to develop, including the specially designed cam.

Some details:

- 316L stainless steel, high-grade aircraft quality aluminum, Durnico, brass, Maillechort, CuBe (copper-beryllium), titanium.
- Eighty-one movement parts; 64 complication parts.
- 40 rubies (20 for movement – 20 for the complication).
- Pin in contact with the cam drive has ruby to limit friction.
- Guidance and support arms are constructed from aluminum to limit the weight of the moving elements.
- Teflon-coated cam wheel.
- Manually wound via a key.
- Power reserve of eight hours.
